This fundamental online course will not only familiarize the student with the CFM strategy, but will teach prayer support development, working effectively with church leadership, an easy-to-follow training template and much more.



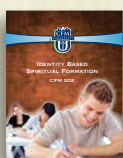
CFM 201: Building and Strengthening CFM Leadership (prerequisite: CFM 101)
