LOOK UP!

Ps. 118:24 "This is the day that the LORD has made, let us rejoice and be glad in it!"

Ps. 8:1-2 (NIV) "LORD, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth! You have set your glory in the heavens. Through the praise of children and infants you have established a stronghold against your enemies, <u>to</u> <u>silence the foe and the avenger</u>."

God is SOVEREIGN

John 10:11

The thief may come to steal, kill, and destroy, but GOD is the GOOD SHEPHERD Who lays down his LIFE for his sheep.

James 5:11

Behold, we consider those blessed who remained steadfast. You have heard of the steadfastness of Job, and you have seen the purpose of the Lord, how the Lord is compassionate and merciful.

The 2 Hands of Authority

James 5:6-7

"God opposes the proud, but gives grace to the humble."

Submit yourselves therefore to God.

The 2 Hands of Authority

James 4: 7b Resist the devil: Taking our authority in Christ and he will flee from you."

... That's a promise



God is God; We're Not

KNOW THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN DESIRE AND AUTHORITY

- ASK God for many things; Only take authority over what is promised.
- We're not owed anything.
- God is most glorified through our surrender to his will, like Christ in the garden of Gethsemane.
- How, when, where is God's call.


- Clay Bergen: "I stand against a spirit of division / rebellion"
- > Abraham was willing to offer Isaac as a sacrifice

(Howard Hendricks: "That living sacrifice keeps crawling off the altar!")

A few examples:

Romans 12:18 *"If possible, so far as it depends on you, live peaceably with all."*

Uniting on a prayer walk, taking authority over our property



Jehoshaphat led Judah to Victory

II Chron. 17-20 He submitted to God, then he didn't, but when he called on God, he answered



- <u>Sought God</u>,
- <u>Fixed their eyes on God</u>,
- They <u>worshipped</u>
- Led their army <u>with praise</u>
- They <u>believed</u> God

HUMBLED THEMSELVES

- <u>Gathered Judah in unity</u>
- They <u>fasted</u>
- They <u>admitted their own</u> <u>powerlessness</u>,

TALKED TOGETHER

- <u>J sought counsel</u>
- They <u>reminded God of his</u> promises
- They <u>reminded God of how He</u> <u>delivered them before</u>

... and God fought the battle for them: the enemies turned on each other! God's people just had to stand. (Eph. 6)



Summary

We are . . . Co-buried, co-raised, co-ascended, and co-seated with Christ: A place of authority---IF we humble ourselves and submit to God.

Not as victims, but as OVERCOMERS, we worship a sovereign God --in the good and bad.

And the enemy will wish he hadn't messed with us!
