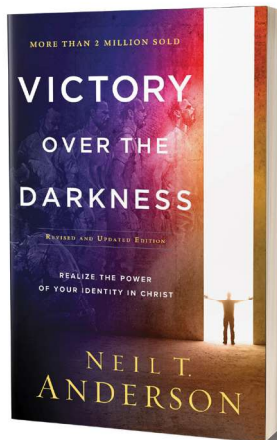

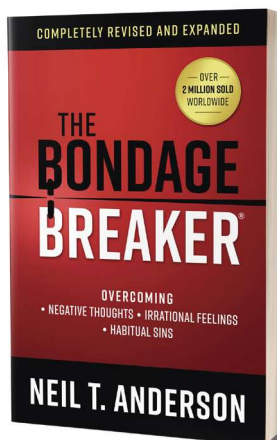


VICTORY OVER THE DARKNESS

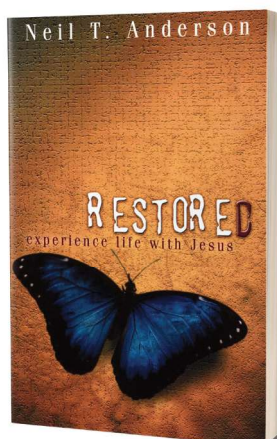

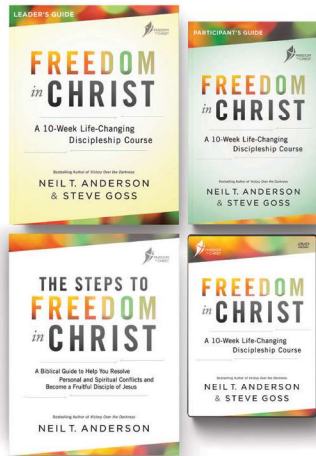

This book starts at the beginning with Creation, the Fall, the Gospel and moves into how to have a deep abiding relationship with Jesus Christ.

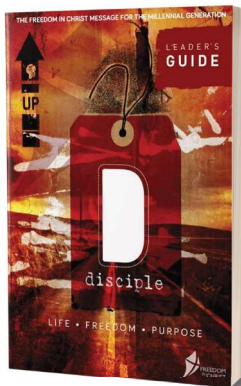

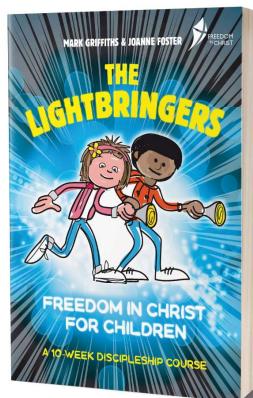

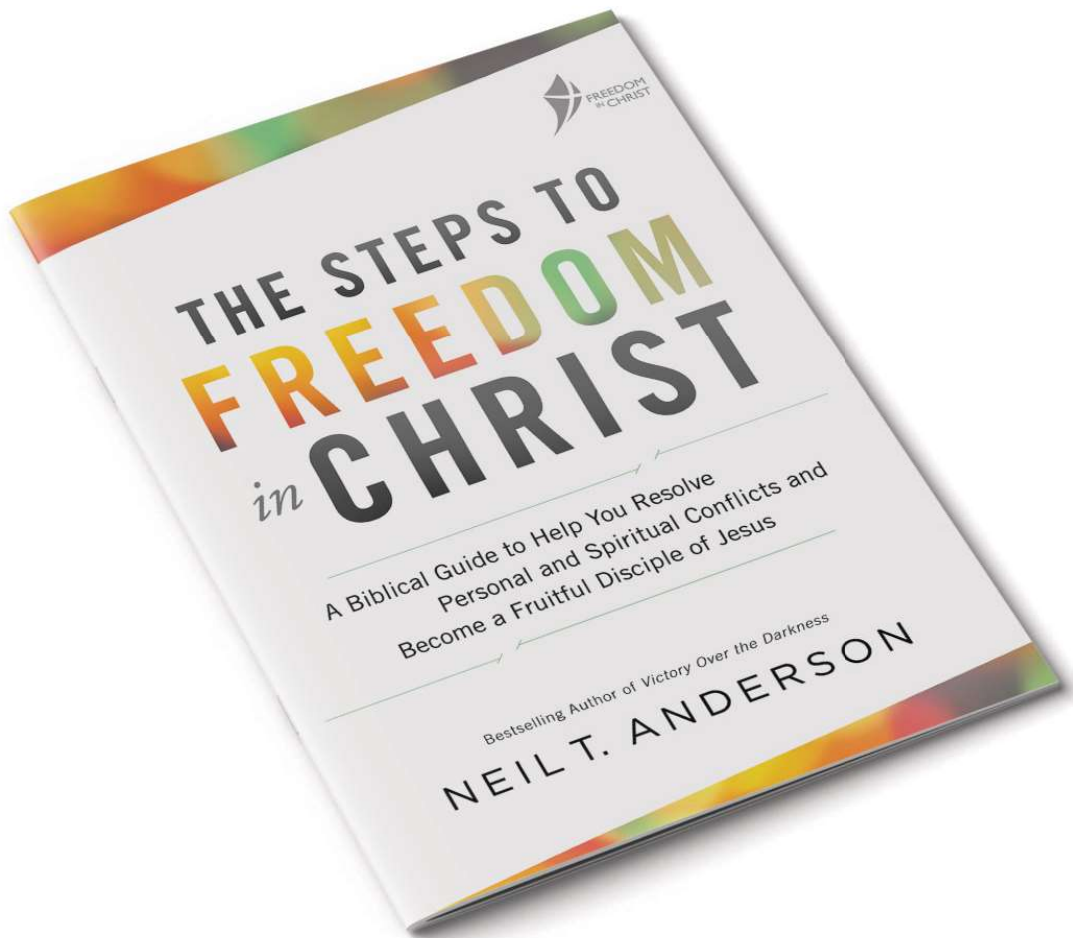


THE LIGHTBRINGERS COURSE

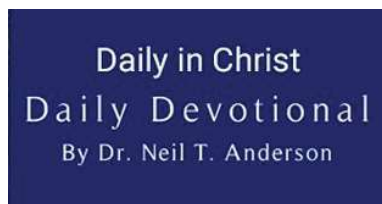

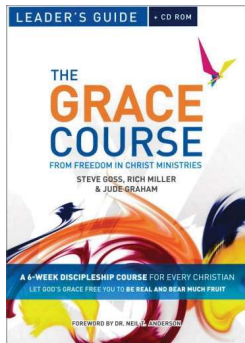

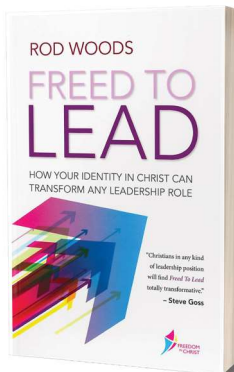

THE GRACE COURSE

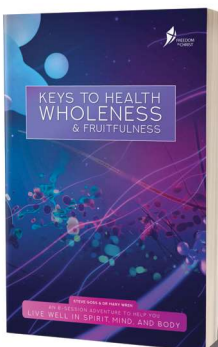
The Grace Course is a straightforward, effective way for churches to help Christians understand God's grace and be motivated by God's love alone, so that they go on to bear "much fruit."

FREED TO LEAD COURSE

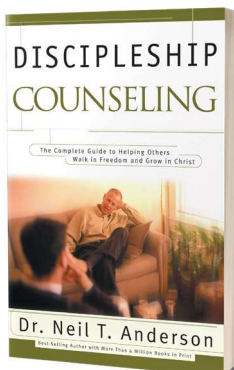

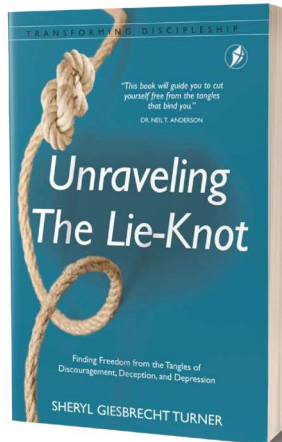
DISCIPLESHIP COUNSELING
