TODAY'S YOUNG GENERATION

- Largest demographic group (32% of the global population)
- Have always been wired...digital natives
- Skilled researchers and fact-checkers
- Visual Multitaskers
- Have seen porn (64% of young people ages 13-24 actively seek out porn weekly or more often)
- Impatient – attention span is 7-8 sec
- Are more accepting of sexual fluidity
- Racially diverse and multiracial
- Independent
- Aware of a troubled planet
- Justice-minded
- Overwhelmed
- Cautious & Pragmatic (58% are worried about the future)
- Teens are 10-15X more impulsive now than 10 years ago
- ANXIOUS
- Lonely
- Want Transparency
- Average time on screens: 9-10 hours per day
 - Teens are missing their 2-3 times of REM Sleep, so brain function suffers
 - Self-inflicting identity disorders

FAITH IN TODAY'S YOUNG GENERATION



- Post-Christian BUT are open to faith
 - Skepticism toward authority
 - Doubt rather than trust
 - Knowledge without wisdom
 - Distorted view of reality
 - Attempts at spiritual formation without foundation
 - Preferential view of truth

Most young people abandon their faith while they are still at home with their parents.

79% of these young people say they walked away from Christianity during their adolescent and teen years. *Many reported that they left the faith between the ages of 10 and 17.*

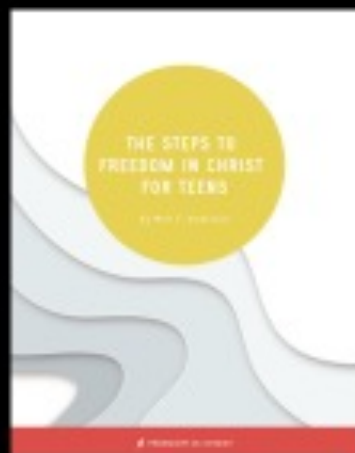
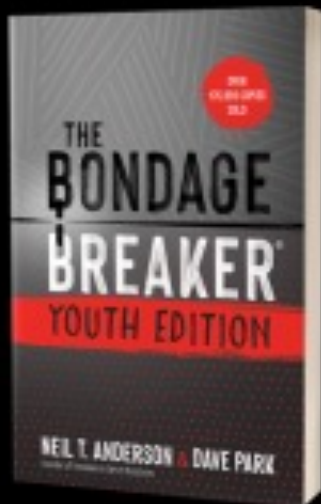
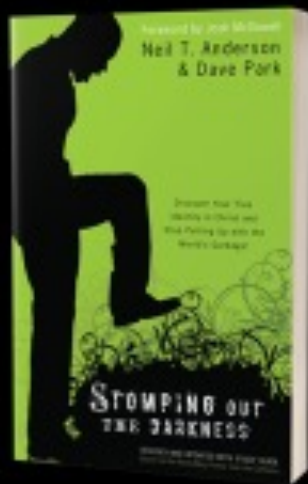
